### PRESENTATION:

City of Spokane Stormwater Department Hazel's Creek Update:

- Demolition of Barn
  - Multiple complaints regarding vandalism, fires set on premises
  - City has spent \$10,000 on maintenance and repair
  - Barn not secure so can't use as storage
  - Attractive nuisance
- Clearing sediment out of first pond will be done later in summer

  - \$981.36 in checking; \$3,000 in escrow account
- Spokane Police Resource Officer Tim Ottman
  - Vehicle prowling up during summer
  - o Remember to keep doors and cars locked and garage doors closed.
- **Community Assembly** Marcy Tunik
  - Code of Conduct for Neighborhood Leaders presented by J Mallahan; Marcy felt it was insulting to people who volunteer their time:
    - Comments: None of the officers of SNC received code
  - Marcy brought up liability insurance for officers of neighborhood councils and relayed situation of developer threatening officers in SNC
  - o Training for CDBG applications on August 27, Teresa Kafentzis will attend
- Waste Management deferred, Andy Hoye not present
- Pedestrian & Trails (PeTT Committee) deferred, Paul Kropp not present
- ONS Clean Up Program Update Teresa Kafentzis

- July extra trash pickup: Almost 12 tons picked up; almost \$3,000 spent
- Will schedule a second extra trash pickup for mid-October
- Neighborhood Planning Update Land Use Committee (Ted Teske)
  - Short Term Rental Stakeholder Team deferred, Andy Hoye not present
  - District Center Vision and 2015 Neighborhood Planning Goal Survey
    - Develop survey
    - Recruit new members; outreach to new apartments
  - Urban Forestry Greening Grants
    - Up to \$5,000 per grant; total of \$75,000 available
    - Applications due by end of August
    - Sites must have access to water; consider low maintenance;
    - Suggest along 44<sup>th</sup> Avenue where plantings not irrigated and now full of tall weeds.
  - Target Opening / New Tenants
    - Anthony's Beach House
    - Mod Pizza
    - Café Rio
    - Nail Salon (only local business)
    - PetSmart
  - o Engineering Permit Appeal Update
    - Hearing scheduled for October
  - KXLY Update
  - Glenrose Cell Tower Update:
    - Verizon tower
    - 60-foot tower, county height restriction,
    - Public meeting in July
    - Public hearings to be scheduled
    - Plan to be built by end of year
  - Havana Street Water Main / Paving Project
    - Replacing water main from 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue in 2015
    - Tentative plans for bike lanes, sidewalks
  - New 55<sup>th</sup> Street Apartments
    - Two buildings for a total of units
