Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon for Regal x Thurston (Southgate Neighborhood)

- Construction crews recently worked near Regal Street and Thurston Avenue to install a new Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHB) that was added in as a part of the City’s the Arterial Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons project, a "citywide initiative to improve pedestrian safety on high-traffic arterial roads."
